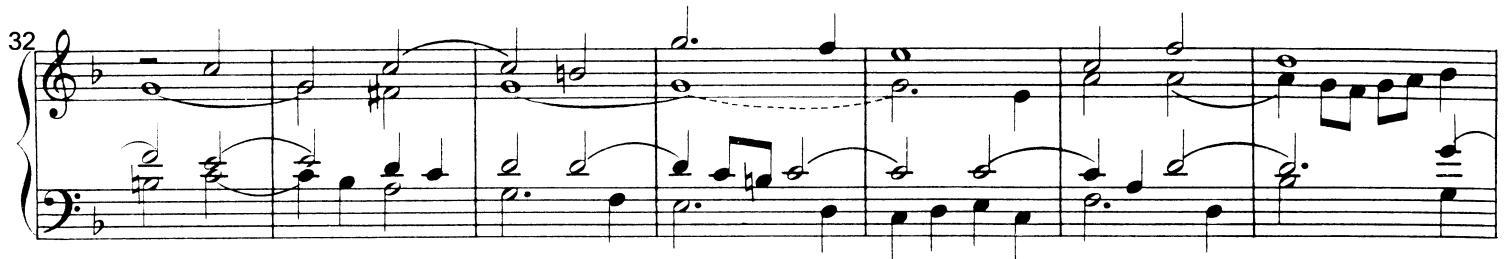
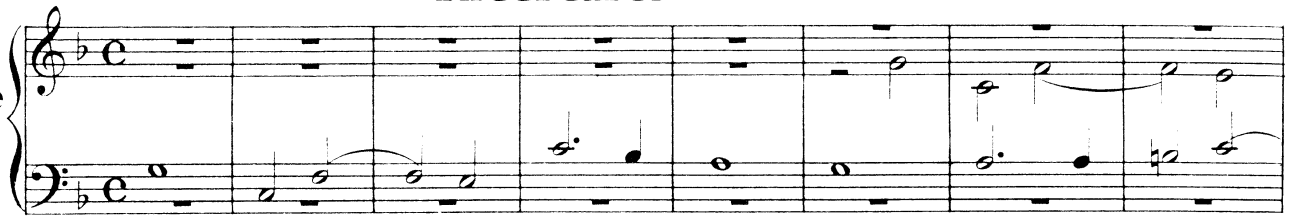

Bibliographical Note

This Dover edition, first published in 1994, is a reproduction of parts I and III of *Johann Jakob Froberger: Orgel- und Klavierwerke*, originally published in *Denkmäler der Tonkunst in Österreich* (Guido Adler, ed.), Vol. 8 (part I: Jahrg. iv/1, 1897) and Vol. 21 (part III: Jahrg. x/2, 1903), by Artaria, Vienna. The facsimile of Froberger's manuscript of *Toccata I* is one of two scores reproduced in Vol. 8. The Dover edition omits the original forewords and appendices, as well as the harpsichord suites and pieces in Vol. 21. A unified list of contents, introduced by a new editorial note and with keys specified, reflects the grouping of music according to genre.
